FULL ON Singapore's gargantuan Marina Bay Sands casino-resort may have stolen the spotlight with its June grand opening, but on the other side of the marina, the Fullerton Bay Hotel Singapore (80 Callyer Quay; 65/6333-8388; fullertonbayhotel.com; doubles from US\$572) is proving that you don't need a gaming floor to be a sure bet. With just 106 rooms and suites, the waterfront property—part of the Fullerton Heritage entertainment complex—is as stylish as they come, with a striking glass facade and three restaurants crafted by Hong Kong designer Andre Fu. All guest quarters come with patios or balconies overlooking the water; splash out on a suite for bespoke artwork, vintage nautical maps, and polished-rosewood screens. –NATASHA DRAGUN
